- Perform specialized and complex professional environmental health inspections and other related work.
- Duties may include conducting environmental health inspections and sanitary surveys at new & existing public water systems, providing operational oversight of public water systems, assisting with compliance and monitoring requirements, and others.
- Responsible for compliance with Public Health Laws, State and County Sanitary Code.
- Assist in Food or Waterborne Illness Investigations and other Communicable Diseases programs.

Requirements

- Bachelor's Degree in chemistry, biology, or physical science, or environmental, chemical, civil, or municipal engineering; or Associate's Degree in engineering science, chemistry, biology, or physical science and 2 years of experience working with water systems.
- Take and be reachable when Civil Service Exam becomes available
- Driver's License in good standing and reliable transportation.

Wage	Entry	\$26.46
