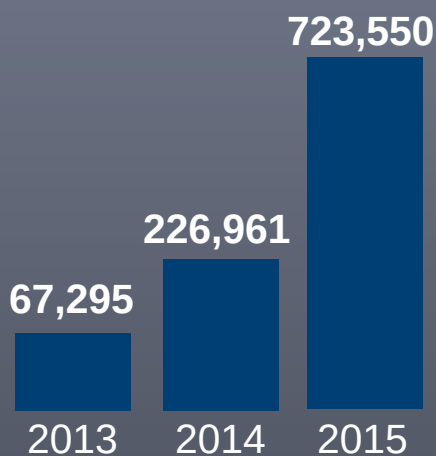

In addition to the contributions of the dedicated volunteers, IHS Coordinated Transportation distributed 2,306 tokens to the 3 offices of Catholic Charities Turning Point, providing an additional 65,000 miles of transportation for those unable to pay for public transit services.



IHS Coordinated Transportation also works with the Steuben County Department of Social Services to provide Transportation Scheduling Services, scheduling over 4,000 client transports by Steuben County drivers in 2015.
