The 2023 Girls on the Run of the Southern Tier end of season **5K Celebration** that took place on Sunday, June 4th, at Bath Central School.

This is the first year since 2019 that all our teams were able to be together in one place.

- We had **23 coaches** (that's 100 % attendance for our regular season GOTR Coaches)
- **132 participants** (that's 94% of our regular season participants) along with their families/friends
- **132 running buddies**
- **71 registered volunteers** to help bring the day together!!

That's approximately **550+ people who attended** this year's event (358 registered individuals, plus an estimated 200 additional family members and friends).

And to top it off, the weather couldn't have been more perfect!

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## Teen Mental Health First Aid

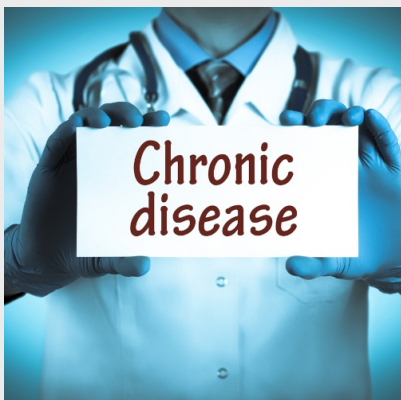
On **June 12, 2023**, SRHN received an award of



\$175,000 to disseminate teen Mental Health First Aid (tMHFA). The grant period term is July 1, 2023, through December 31, 2024. tMHFA teen Mental Health First Aid (tMHFA) will help prepare teens in grades 10-12, or ages 15-18, in Steuben and Chemung counties to identify, understand and respond to signs of mental health and substance use challenges among their friends and peers.

## Evidence-Based Programming

Earlier this year, Rural Health Network of South Central, NY proposed a partnership with the Steuben Rural Health Network, along with Tioga Opportunities and Gerould's, to participate in a grant opportunity through Agency for Community Living (ACL).



This proposal would increase the capacity to deliver and create sustainability of Chronic Disease Self-Management Program and Chronic Pain Self-Management Program in Broome, Tioga, Delaware, Chemung, and Steuben Counties.

On **May 3, 2023**, "Building Capacity and Sustainability for Evidence-based Self-Management, SRHN was notified that the grant was approved. This new collaboration will provide additional Master Trainers and Peer Leaders to ultimately increase the number of participants in Chronic Disease Self-Management Education programs throughout the 5 program counties.
