Steuben County Releases July Overdose Data

Steuben County Public Health

BATH, NY – The Steuben County Public Health Department and partners are sharing updated overdose data for July: 39 overdoses were reported. Two overdoses were fatal, and 16 instances of Narcan administration were cited.

"The overdose trend continues to be concerning, with July pushing Steuben to about 80% of the total overdoses seen in all of 2022," said Public Health Director, Darlene Smith. "Overdose fatalities reported through July account for 83% of what occurred in



2022. Help is available. Contact 211 for local resources."
