Travel Training is a free program offered through Steuben Coordinated Transportation Mobility Management that is designed for seniors and people with disabilities or anyone who needs guidance on learning how to navigate the bus system. It provides the assistance necessary for each person to successfully use Steuben County's public fixed route bus services. Travel Training can be group focused or individualized.
